On this 19th day of May 2022, the City Council of Dodd City met in a regular session after public notice was posted on the 16th of May 2022, with the following council members present unless noted as absent. Below are the minutes of that meeting:

Roll call was completed and quorum established at 7:05 pm. Mayor Davis called the meeting to order at 7:05 pm.

Nancy Bridges requested that the city assist her in getting more information about her properties in Dodd City. A records request form was later mailed to her.

Brian Hilliard spoke about work that needed to be done on the alarm system at the wastewater treatment plant, and about the desire to switch over to electronic water meters in Dodd City.

Councilmember Fry made a motion to go into executive session at 7:47 pm. Councilmember Keene seconded the motion and all voted yes.

Councilmember Lackey made a motion to go back into open meeting at 7:51, councilmember Fry seconded it and the meeting returned to an open meeting.

Councilmember Lackey made a motion to accept the resignation of councilmember Dillon Weeks. Councilmember Fry seconded the motion and all voted yes.

Councilmember Keene made a motion to accept the appointment of Becky Herpeche to fill the seat vacated by the resigning councilman Weeks. Councilmember Fry seconded the motion, and all voted yes.

Councilmember Keene made a motion to elect councilmember Fry as the new mayor pro-tem. Councilmember Lackey seconded the motion, and all voted yes.

Councilman Lackey made a motion to adopt a resolution to deny the proposed ONCOR rate change for electric delivery. Councilmember Fry seconded, and all voted yes.

Councilmember Lackey made a motion to have a city-wide spring cleanup on July 8th, 9th and 10th. Councilman Keene seconded the motion, and all voted yes.

The proposal to develop an ordinance to provide for the payment of water bills by electronic means was tabled for now with no action.

Councilmember Lackey made a motion to approve the consent agenda. Councilmember Keene seconded the motion, and all voted yes.

Councilmember Fry made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 7:55 pm. Councilmember Lackey seconded the motion and all voted yes.
