
On this 13th day of September 2022, the City Council of Dodd City met in a regular meeting after public notice was posted on the 10th of September, with all councilmembers present:



- Item 1:** The city secretary conducted a roll call and established a quorum at 7:04 pm.
- Item 2:** Mayor Tim Davis called the meeting to order at 7:04.
- Item 3:** Mayor Davis opened the public hearing for the proposed 2022-2023 budget at 7:05.
- Item 4:** No public citizen spoke on the proposed budget, so the public hearing for the 2022-2023 budget was closed at 7:10.
- Item 5:** Mayor Davis opened the public hearing for the proposed 2022-2023 tax rate at 7:10.
- Item 6:** No public citizen spoke on the proposed 2022-2023 tax rate, so the public hearing was closed at 7:15.
- Item 7:** Councilmember Lackey made a motion to approve the consent agenda. Councilmember Hilliard seconded the motion, and all members voted in favor.
- Item 8:** Public Forum – Joel Nash spoke on his desire to coordinate between the engineer for his proposal to build houses and duplexes on property between HWY 56 and Fourth Street in Dodd City and the city’s engineer, and stated that he wishes to be placed on the October city council meeting agenda to further discuss his plans.
- Item 9:** Councilmember Fry made a motion to pass ordinance #09132022-1 adopting a budget for the City of Dodd City for fiscal year 2022-2023. Councilmember Lackey seconded the motion, and all members responded to a roll call vote in favor of the ordinance.
- Item 10:** Councilmember Keene made a motion to pass ordinance #09132022-2 ratifying that the 2022-2023 annual budget will require raising more revenue from property taxes than in the previous year. Councilmember Herpeche seconded the motion, and all members responded to a roll call vote in favor of the ordinance.
- Item 11:** Councilmember Hilliard made a motion to pass ordinance #09132022-3 setting the 2022-2023 M&O tax rate for the City of Dodd City. Councilmember Fry seconded the motion, and all members responded to a roll call vote in favor of the ordinance.
- Item 12:** Councilmember Keene made a motion to pass ordinance #09132022-4 establishing a tax rate for the City of Dodd City to pay the principal and interest on the funded debt of the city and levying a tax on all property subject to taxation within the city of Dodd City, Texas. Councilmember Lackey seconded the motion, and all members responded to a roll call vote in favor of the ordinance.
- Item 13:** Councilmember Keene made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Councilmember Fry seconded the motion, and all members voted in favor. The meeting was adjourned at 7:41 pm.
