



- Item #1.** Roll was called and a quorum was established at 7:07 by the City Secretary.
- Item #2.** Mayor Davis called the meeting to order at 7:07.
- Item #3.** Councilmember Lackey made a motion to approve the consent agenda; Councilmember Ferguson seconded it. And all voted for it.
- Item #4.** Jessica Arnold spoke on behalf of her campaign for district attorney, and Cody Shook spoke on behalf of his campaign for sheriff.
- Item #5.** Councilmember Kene made a motion to order the May 4, 2024 General Election and May 4, 2024 Special Election; Councilmember Ferguson seconded it, and all voted for it.
- Item #6:** Councilmember Herpeche made a motion to approve the Interlocal Cooperation Agreement between Fannin County and the City of Dodd City Regarding Platt Approval Jurisdiction with in the Extraterritorial Jurisdiction (ETJ) of the City of Dodd City; Councilmember Lackey seconded it, and all voted for.
- Item #7:** Councilmember Ferguson made a motion to adopt an ordinance setting the prima facie speed limit for Fifth Street in the City of Dodd City at 30 miles per hour as provided by the Texas Transportation Code.
- Item #8:** Councilmember Keene made a motion to approve the mayor and councilmember Lackey to have an on-line meeting with Safe Built code enforcement personnel about potentially hiring them for code enforcement issues in the City of Dodd City.
