

- Item #1.** Roll was called and a quorum was established at 7:01 by the City Secretary.
- Item #2.** Mayor Davis called the meeting to order at 7:01.
- Item #3.** Councilmember Ferguson made a motion to approve the consent agenda; Councilmember Keene seconded it, and all voted for it.
- Item #4.** JP Kenny Karl spoke about being our municipal judge beginning in the next few months.
- Item #5.** Councilmember Keene made a motion to accept the Certificate of Unopposed Candidates for the May 4th General and Special Election; Councilmember Herpeche seconded the motion, and all voted for it.
- Item #6:** Councilmember Keene made a motion to cancel the May 4th General and Special Elections for the City of Dodd City; Councilmember Herpeche seconded the motion, and all voted for it.
- Item #7:** Councilmember Hilliard made a motion to approve the emergency expenditure for repairs to water well #2; Councilmember Ferguson seconded the motion, and all voted for it.
- Item #8:** Councilmember Herpeche made a motion to table the discussion on the Interlocal Contract between the City of Dodd City and Fannin County on maintenance and street repairs within the City of Dodd City until more acceptable language could be achieved between the City and County; Councilmember Hilliard seconded the motion, and all voted for it.
- Item#9:** Councilmember Keene made a motion to table signing a contract between the City and Safe Built Corporation (SBC) to do code enforcement work for Dodd City since SBC officials could not attend the meeting as planned; Councilmember Ferguson seconded the motion, and all voted for it.
- Item #10:** Public Works/Utilities Director Brian Hilliard spoke on the need for a possible ordinance to limit what businesses, schools, etc, can dump into the city's sewer system to assure that the system works properly.
- Item #11.** Councilmember Keene made a motion to adjourn the meeting; Councilmember Ferguson seconded the motion, and all voted for it. Meeting adjourned at 8:01.
